- Buildings have a low-carbon and material-efficient lifecycle

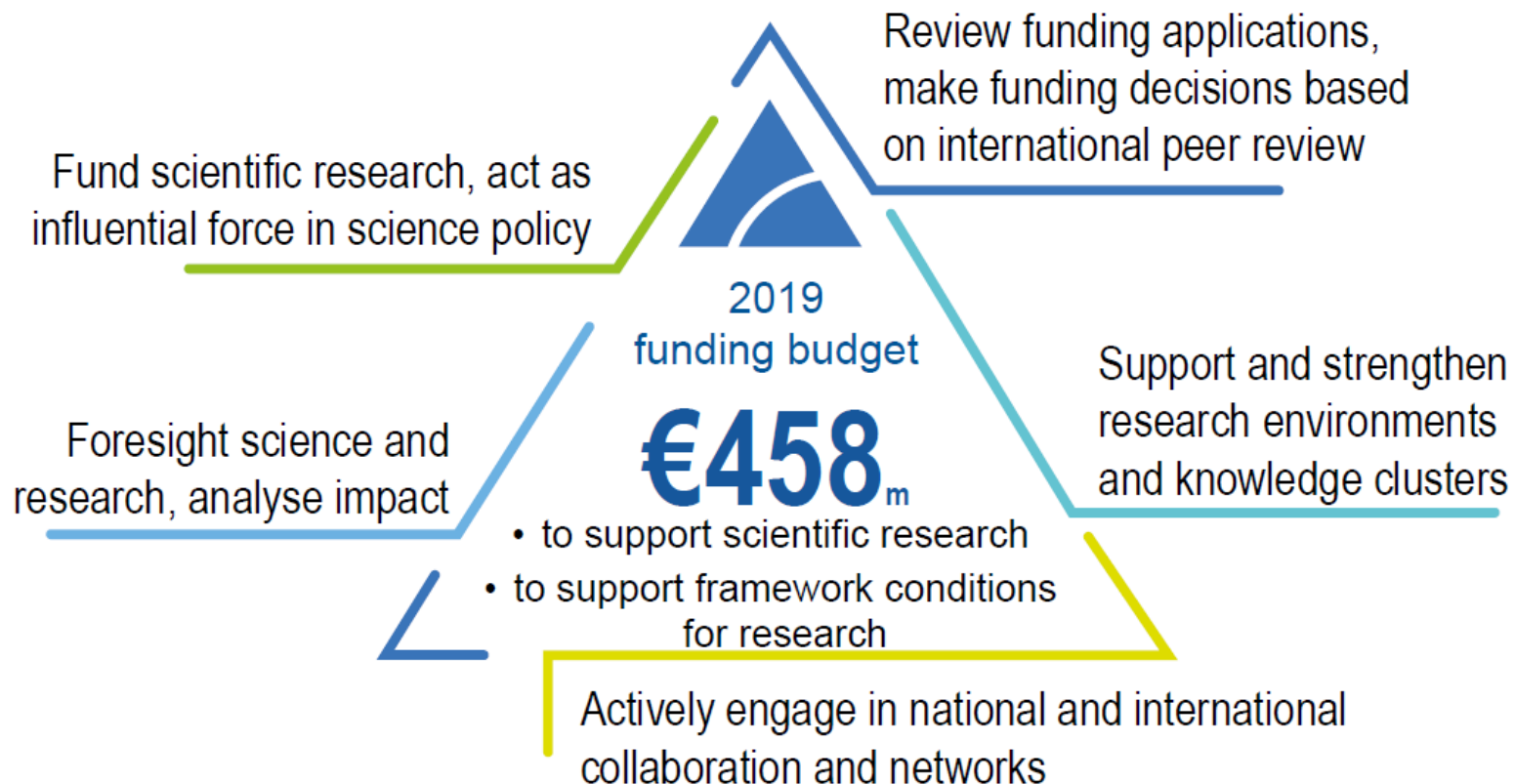
## 3 Sustainable urban development
