



EU funded forest related proects



Less forest specific calls and funding schemes (e.g., COST)





EFI Network Fund aim

Support transnational cooperation and strengthen involvement of institutions from Eastern Europe

What is funded?

- The EFI Network Fund supports transnational activities, like joint research initiatives, knowledge networking, capacity building, aiming at:
 - common understanding/definition of the subject matter [SEP]
 - comparison of models, scenarios, simulations, methodologies, etc.
 - specific tangible output that cannot be achieved without international coordination
 - Dissemination of research results
 - Fostering knowledge exchange and the development of joint research agendas
 - Bringing knowledge to specific target groups (e.g., young researchers, regional focus)


Focus on EFI strategic themes

- EFI Network Fund Actions shall address one or more topics within the EFI's strategic themes
 - Bioeconomy
 - Resilience
 - Governance

Who can apply?

- Exclusively for EFI associate and affiliate member organizations
 - at least 4 EFI Member Organisations from at least 4 different European

Others can join but no reimbursement



Funding

- The requested EFI Network Fund Contribution does not exceed 100,000€.
- Funded by EFI membership fees (app. 175 k€/year) and other donations
- 2 calls planned
 - 1st for the period 2018-2019 (400 k€)
 - 2nd for the period 2020-2021 (600 k€)

EFI Network Fund (1st call statistics)

- 17 application received
- 5 projects funded (39 institutions from 19 countries):
