



Promotion of research, development and demonstration


- commodity crops from agriculture, forestry and aquatic biomass,

- cross-cutting issues, including a dialogue with society





Tasks of FNR: European and International Projects

→ Partner for renewable resources projects also on EU/International level on behalf of the Federal Ministry of Food and Agriculture

- Coordinator/partner of around 15 ongoing EU projects
- Development of EU projects (H2020, BBI JU, Interreg)
- Member of international and EU expert panels
- Analysis of political developments and framework conditions in the European Union
- Information and advice about European funding opportunities for German applicants



Conclusions and outlook

- 963 million € R&D funding by BMEL since 1993 related to bioproducts and bioenergy
- Addressing the full range of value chains and applications
- Scientific and technical successes in all sub-areas
- R&D priorities and political framework not always consistent
- R&D time requirements and policy changes do not match
- Important role of bioproducts and bioenergy to achieve EU and national economic, energy and climate targets for 2030 and beyond
